

D3D++ licensing as of PolyWorks 2025

Facts

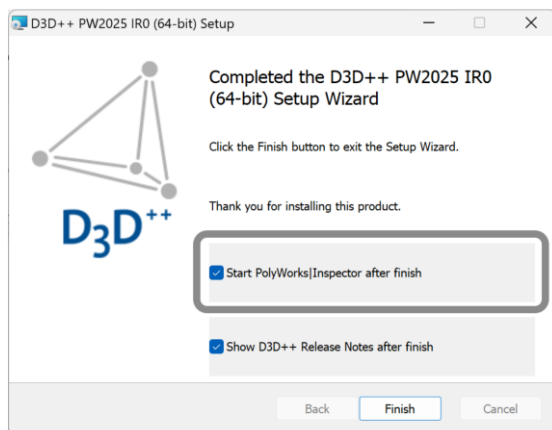
The D3D++ plug-in is licensed with the release of PolyWorks 2025. The respective version of the plug-in can be activated using the license key provided.

D3D++ Standard and D3D++ Pro Automation are available.

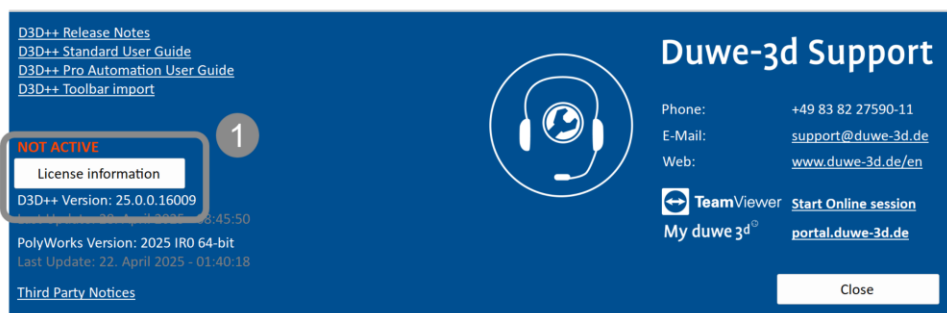
D3D++ Installation

As before, you will find the latest PolyWorks and D3D++ installation files in the **Downloads** section of the **My Duwe-3d portal**.

Download and install both files. During the D3D++ installation, check the box **Start PolyWorks Inspector after finish** to automatically open the Inspector after installation.

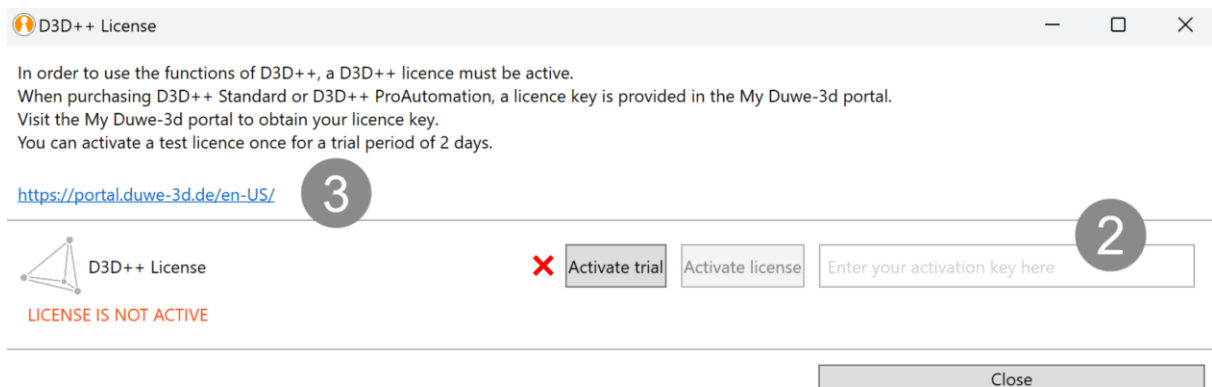


This will display the D3D++ info window directly. No D3D++ licence is currently active (1). Click on the **License information** field to open the license window.



Import D3D++ license file

The D3D++ license key is then copied into the field provided (2) and the license is activated.



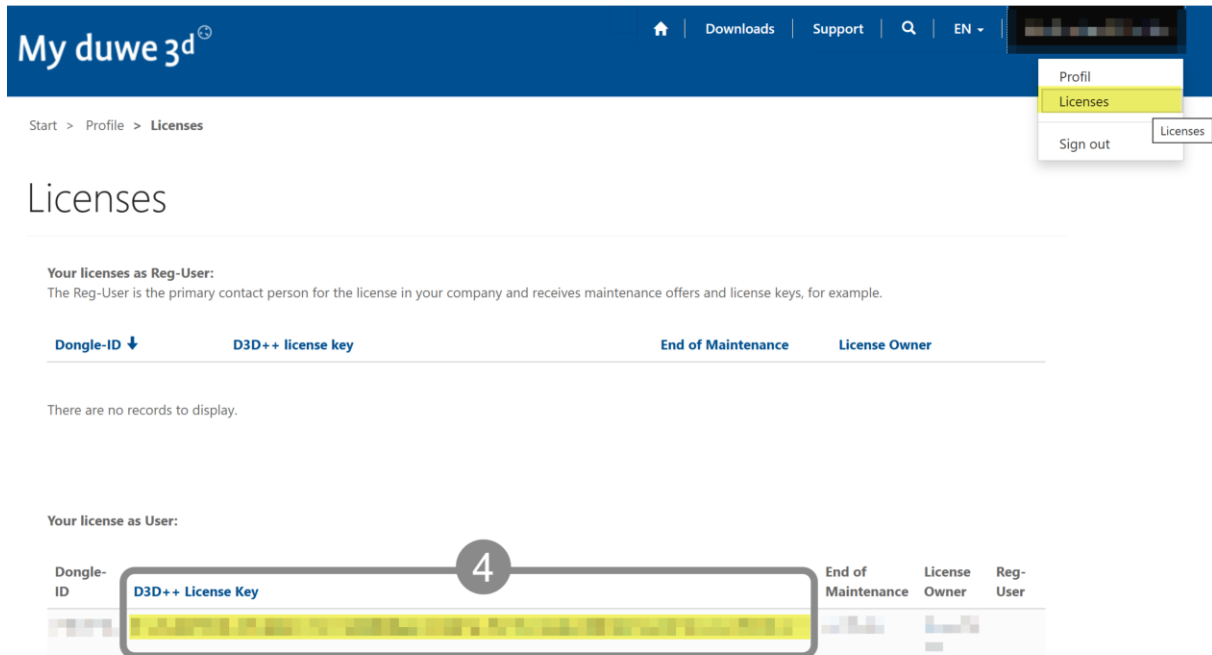
The link (3) takes you to the start page of the **My Duwe-3d portal**.

Copying the D3D++ license key

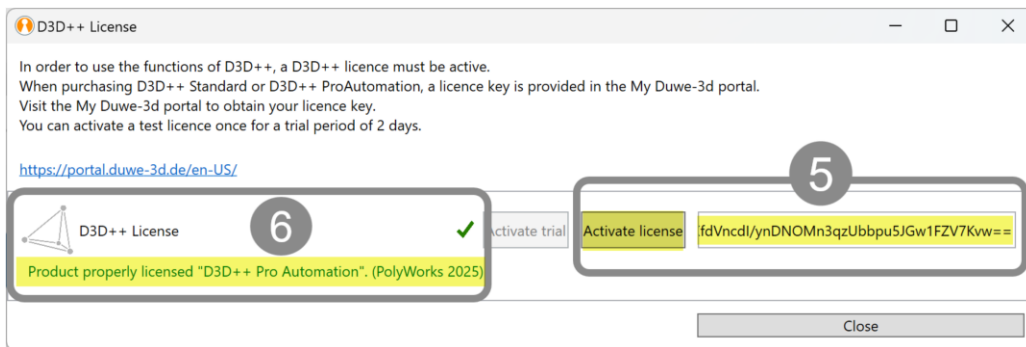
Under the user profile in the **My Duwe 3d portal**, you can find the *license section*. The PolyWorks licenses assigned to the user are displayed here.

If D3D++ is a product of the PolyWorks license, a long D3D++ license key is displayed. This entire entry (4) must be copied here and pasted into the corresponding field in D3D++ (5).



After successful activation, the purchased D3D++ product is visible (6) and ready for use.

A distinction is made between D3D++ Standard and Pro Automation.

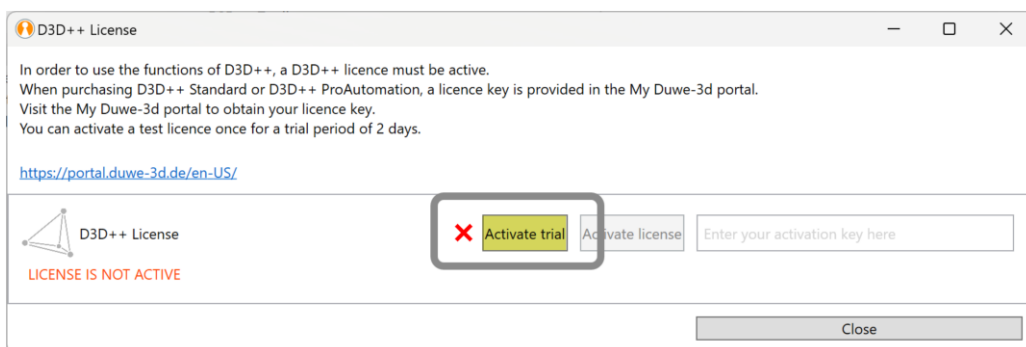


General information

A D3D++ license is always directly linked to a PolyWorks licence. If a PolyWorks license is used by several users on several computers, the D3D++ license key must be entered several times, by each user on each computer.

Test license

If you want to test D3D++, you can activate a **60-day** trial period. This activation is for **single use only** and cannot be extended.



Troubleshooting

No D3D++ license key is displayed in the portal? In this case, please contact **Duwe-3d Support**. We can check whether it is a technical problem or if the PolyWorks license you are using does not yet include D3D++. Our sales department will be happy to provide you with a quote for the future use of D3D++.

Please note that for **floating licenses**, the **Dongle ID** entry must correspond to the current **Server name (host name)**. If this is not the case, please contact Duwe-3d Support.
